



Megan Carney (she/her) is the Artistic Director of About Face Theater and a founding director of AFT's education programs where she produces and directs projects that advance dialogue about gender and sexuality. Her work as a director and playwright has premiered in Chicago, New York, and in touring productions around the country. She served as the Director of the Gender and Sexuality Center, one of the Centers for Cultural Understanding and Social Change, at the University of Illinois at Chicago where she developed and supported programming on systemic change and intersectional LGBTQIA+ identities and histories. Carney has a MFA in Theatre Arts from Virginia Tech with a focus on Directing and Public Dialogue and teaches in various settings. Megan volunteered on the LGBT Giving Council of the Chicago Foundation for Women and with the Chicago Restroom Access Project of Pride Action Tank. Her work has been featured in various publications and recognized with theatre industry awards, the GLSEN Pathfinder Award, an APA Presidential Citation, and induction in Chicago's LGBT Hall of Fame.
